Study Zone Sessions are a way for clients currently participating in Tacoma Community Houses' REACH program to build up their study skills and learn more about navigating online education. These sessions are on a rotating basis every other week, going over topics such as technology and website navigation, different ways to study, and homework support. Students are given a space to focus on learning and being able to take charge of their education.

As a Study Zone Volunteer Tutor, you will assist students in these preset lessons and help guide them to educational resources. You will help us in facilitating an open, academic space where students can gain support to become self-sustaining in their studies.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 22 years old
- Experience working in education either as a teacher or a paraprofessional or having successfully completed any 4-year degree
- Passion for the mission and vision of Tacoma Community House and our REACH Center program
- Ability to work with groups of young adults with various levels of barriers and with a variety of backgrounds

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Help set up and take down supplies, snacks, tables, and chairs for sessions
- Leading groups of young adults in preset lessons pertaining to navigating websites and various study skills
- Answering questions in relation to the lessons and facilitation homework help as needed

- Getting familiar with the resources we have and guiding students to them when needed
- Taking attendance
- Maintaining confidentiality with the students and with others
- Harboring a safe space and an educational environment for students to be heard and respected
